The current zoning is F1 Forest Use Zone. The Deschutes County F1 Forest Use Zone is intended to conserve forest lands with a minimum 240-acre parcel size. Uses permitted outright include: forest operations or forest practices, uses to provide for wildlife and fishery resources, and farm uses. Conditional uses permitted include: private hunting and fishing, private parks and campgrounds, single family dwellings and operations, to name a few. The development potential of the property is significant and expected to grow over time due to the proximity and location of the property to the Bend locale and the surrounding National Forest and Wilderness areas.
