TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

The Parador de Alcañiz in Teruel is located in one of the most complex monument sites in Aragon. This enormous enclosure, half castle and half convent, impresses the traveller with its imposing silhouette that looms over the entire area. The building which was erected in the 12th and 13th centuries, still retains its keep, the bell tower, the sacristy and the part rebuilt as an Aragonese palace. The Plateresque tomb, the Baroque façade and its peaceful garden have also been preserved. Special mention must be made of its 14th-century Gothic frescoes, undoubtedly one of the castle's gems. Guests can have breakfast in the cloister, enjoy a glass of wine in the gallery, or read on the sofa while they wait for dusk to fall behind the walls. The Parador de Alcañiz has everything you need to forget your daily routine and to relax. The ample spaces and the carefully decorated interiors enhance the outside light, making the rooms warm and welcoming places that are hard to leave. All the Parador's windows look out onto the town of Alcañiz, which has a rich history. Stare wide-eyed at its medieval underground sections, the Fountain with 72 Spouts, or the Gothic Lonja. And have fun at the MotorLand Aragón circuit which offers a sports area in which to practice autocross, karting or motocross, and enjoy competitions such as the MotoGP Grand Prix of Aragon.

ABOUT THE AREA

Spain or the Kingdom of Spain (Reino de España) is a country in southwestern Europe with parts of territory in the Atlantic Ocean and across the Mediterranean Sea. The largest part of Spain is situated on the Iberian Peninsula; its territory also includes the Canary Islands in the Atlantic Ocean, the Balearic Islands in the Mediterranean Sea, the autonomous cities of Ceuta and Melilla, and several minor overseas territories also scattered along the Moroccan coast of the Alboran Sea. The country's mainland is bordered to the south by Gibraltar; to the south and east by the Mediterranean Sea; to the north by France, Andorra and the Bay of Biscay; and to the west by Portugal and the Atlantic Ocean.

Aragon is an autonomous community in Spain, coextensive with the medieval Kingdom of Aragon. In northeastern Spain, the Aragonese autonomous community comprises three provinces (from north to south): Huesca, Zaragoza, and Teruel.

Teruel is a province of Aragon, in the northeast of Spain. The capital is Teruel. It is bordered by the provinces of Tarragona, Castellón, Valencia (including its exclave Rincón de Ademuz), Cuenca, Guadalajara, and Zaragoza. The area of the province is 14,809 km². It contains 236 municipalities, of which more than half are villages of under 200 people. Teruel is the second-least populated province of Spain, also the second smallest in population density after Soria.

Alcañiz is a town and municipality of Teruel province in the autonomous community of Aragon, Spain. The town is located on the banks of the river Guadalope. Alcañiz is the unofficial capital of the Lower Aragon historical region. It lies some 113 km from Teruel, the provincial capital, and 92 km from Zaragoza, the capital of Aragon.
