TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Surrounded by exuberant nature, at the foot of the imposing Monte Perdido, lies the Parador de Bielsa. Situated in the heart of the Pineta Valley, this hotel is the ideal starting point for excursions, mountain sports, or simply a break from routine. The building, which dates back to 1968, was renovated in 2002 to expand its room and restaurant capacity. A modern building that looks like a mountain shelter, stone and wood are the predominant materials used in its construction. Its cuisine, a point of reference in the region, is noteworthy for its inclusion of game, veal from Aragon, and homemade desserts such as Pasteras and Teresitas. The Pineta Valley is the most spectacular enclave in the Wild Pyrenees. An impressive cirque born from glacial ice and the waters of the river Cinca, which sustains this landscape of waterfalls, beech forests and the impressive vegetation that abounds in this area. It is also the gateway to the Ordesa y Monte Perdido National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The beautiful town of Bielsa has an old quarter with gems such as the Romanesque chapel of Nuestra Señora de Pineta. It's famous for its carnival, held at the end of winter, when unique characters parade through the streets and ancestral traditions are renewed.

ABOUT THE AREA

Spain or the Kingdom of Spain (Reino de España) is a country in southwestern Europe with parts of territory in the Atlantic Ocean and across the Mediterranean Sea. The largest part of Spain is situated on the Iberian Peninsula; its territory also includes the Canary Islands in the Atlantic Ocean, the Balearic Islands in the Mediterranean Sea, the autonomous cities of Ceuta and Melilla, and several minor overseas territories also scattered along the Moroccan coast of the Alboran Sea. The country's mainland is bordered to the south by Gibraltar; to the south and east by the Mediterranean Sea; to the north by France, Andorra and the Bay of Biscay; and to the west by Portugal and the Atlantic Ocean.

Aragon is an autonomous community in Spain, coextensive with the medieval Kingdom of Aragon. In northeastern Spain, the Aragonese autonomous community comprises three provinces (from north to south): Huesca, Zaragoza, and Teruel.

Huesca is a province of northeastern Spain, in northern Aragon. The capital is Huesca. Positioned just south of the central Pyrenees, Huesca borders France and the French Departments of Haute-Garonne, Pyrénées-Atlantiques and Hautes-Pyrénées. Within Spain, Huesca's neighboring provinces are Navarre, Zaragoza and Lleida.

Bielsa is a municipality located in the province of Huesca, Aragon, Spain. The Bielsa tunnel under the Pyrenean mountains connects Bielsa and Aragnouet in France.
