ABOUT THE AREA

The Leeward Islands Is a Group of Islands Located in the Eastern Caribbean Sea. The Term "Leeward" Refers to the Direction Away From the Prevailing Winds, as These Islands Are Situated on the Western Side of the Lesser Antilles Chain, the Leeward Islands Extend From the Virgin Islands in the North to Dominica in the South. They Form Part of the Lesser Antilles, Which Is a Chain of Islands Stretching From Puerto Rico to the Coast of South America. The Leeward Islands Are Nestled Between the Atlantic Ocean to the East and the Caribbean Sea to the West.

Saint Kitts and Nevis, Officially the Federation of Saint Christopher and Nevis, Is an Island Country and Microstate Consisting of the Two Islands of Saint Kitts and Nevis, Both Located in the West Indies, in the Leeward Islands Chain of the Lesser Antilles. With 261 Square Kilometres (101 Sq Mi) of Territory, It Is the Smallest Sovereign State in the Western Hemisphere

Nevis Is a Small Island in the Caribbean Sea That Forms Part of the Inner Arc of the Leeward Islands Chain of the West Indies. Nevis and the Neighbouring Island of Saint Kitts Constitute the Federation of Saint Kitts and Nevis, a Singular Nation State. Nevis Is Located Near the Northern End of the Lesser Antilles Archipelago About 350 Kilometres (220 Mi) East-Southeast of Puerto Rico and 80 Kilometres (50 Mi) West of Antigua. Its Area Is 93 Square Kilometres (36 Sq Mi) and the Capital Is Charlestown. Saint Kitts and Nevis are separated by The Narrows, a shallow 3-kilometre (2 mi) channel. Nevis is roughly conical in shape with a volcano known as Nevis Peak at its centre.
